Advenvida - Adventist Life Style Clinic	Advenvida is an Adventist lifestyle clinic, which was developed to meet the need to impact the city of Bogota with medical missionary work reaching the most vulnerable populations of the city and supplying the medical needs of interfaith communities with emphasis on the Muslim community. Some of the most evident health problems in the city of Bogota that directly affect low-income localities and impact the interfaith communities are: (1) Increase in mortality due to malnutrition in children under 5 years of age. (2) The city continues to reports the highest number of deaths by suicide in Colombia. (3) Chronic non-communicable diseases (HT, diabetes, cancer) are the leading cause of morbidity and mortality. It is crucial within our mission policy to highlight the importance of a good health care service, taking into account the beliefs of the different actors in the city, for example: access to health care for Muslim women is influenced by social interactions that sometimes hinder communication with health professionals. It is essential to promote health and medical checkups for disease prevention in order to achieve respect for their culture as a key factor in public health.	Palermo SDA Church	Bogota	IAD
Youth Alive in Samsun	Our group consists of eight young individuals, and is rapidly expanding, who are actively engaged and committed to fostering a positive community spirit. The weekly meetings with the youth have become a cornerstone of our initiative, providing a platform for open discussion, learning, and personal growth. Many young people in our area are looking for guidance and often succumb to addictive behaviors like smoking, alcohol and drugs abuse due to their strong social appeal. Topics such as sexuality, often seen as taboo, are not openly discussed in families, leaving the youth without mentorship or sufficient information to make healthy life choices. The initiation of the Youth Alive project in Samsun is crucial to reach out to these youth, both from the Adventist community and beyond, providing them with mentorship and support to make healthier and more meaningful life decisions, thereby fostering a closer relationship with God.
